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THE WORLD FAIR TRADE WEEK

The World Fair Trade Week is the most important event for Fair Trade at the global level. The 2015 edition will be held in Milan, from May 22 to 31, 2015: for seven days, the city will become "Fair Trade Capital of the world". The World Fair Trade Week is organized by WFTO-World Fair Trade Organization – which gathers 450 Fair Trade member organizations from 70 different countries - and by AGICES-Equo Garantito – the Italian trade association of Fair Trade organizations – together with the Municipality of Milan.

THEMES OF THE WEEK

The focus of the Week – which will translate into various forms and events – is the deep and innovative meaning of *Fair Trade**: the "tale" of *Fair Trade* will come alive thanks to the presence in town of hundreds of producers, farmers and artisans form all over the world. The picking of Milan as the Week's host city during the first month of Expo2015 – the Universal Exposition, with its official

theme 'Feeding the Planet, Energy for Life' -will make for a unique opportunity to bring the Fair Trade approach and ideas at the centre of the global debate on production and distribution of food. Among the many events of the Week: Milano Fair City – the first World Fair Trade Fair – and the biennial WFTO Conference.

RESPONSIBILITY

Another key concept is that of "responsibility" – and of how Fair Trade Organizations ensure product excellence and quality, virtuous supply-chains for all and real development to truly "feed" the world – the very same purpose at the core of the Equo Garantito guarantee system. The ultimate goal is to give an opportunity to speak up to the representatives of thousands of communities of artisans and farmers in Asia, Latin America and Africa, and to those who seek to rewrite the rules of trade based on social and environmental sustainability.

* Fair Trade is a trading partnership, based on dialogue, transparency and respect, that seeks greater equity in international trade. It contributes to sustainable development by offering better trading conditions to, and securing the rights of, marginalized producers and workers - especially in the South. Fair Trade organizations have a clear commitment to Fair Trade as the principal core of their mission. They, backed by consumers, are engaged actively in supporting producers, awareness raising and in campaigning for changes in the rules and practice of conventional international trade.

ALL THE WFTW2015 EVENTS



Over 300 delegates representing Fair Trade organizations and producers from all over the world will met up in Milan for the biennial WFTO - World Fair Trade Organization Conference, at the Klima Hotel, from the 24th to the 27th of May.



The first World Fair Trade Fair – from the 28th to the 31st of May, 2015 – in the stunning venue of Fabbrica del Vapore, in the city centre of Milan.
250 exhibitors from 30 different countries, from food to handicraft, from exotic to "domestic Fair Trade" products, from development cooperation projects to the Italian social economy. The program includes high-level conferences and debates, workshops, tastings and fair/organic food stands and cafeterias.

From the 29th to the 31st of May, the halls of the Politecnico di Milano University will host the fifth *Fair Trade International* Symposium. Researchers, practitioners and professors will discuss how to further develop the Fair Trade movement, analysing its key factors and values. The central theme will be "Critically Developing the Fair Trade Movement: Trade justice in food, fashion and craft".



Over 30 restaurants in Milan and in the rest of Italy, with some of their most prestigious chefs, will offer menus, dishes and tastings, all inspired by Fair Trade ingredients.

FAIR & ETHICAL FASHION SHOW MILAN

Fair and Ethical Fashion Show: From the 22nd to the 24th of May, the Ex Ansaldo venue – at the very centre of the Milan Fashion District in Via Tortona 54 – will host the first fair, ethical and sustainable fashion show, showcasing Italian and international projects: an exhibition ground to highlight products and a debating area for conferences.

WFTO - World Fair Trade Organization, established in 1989 – has more than 450 members, gathering Fair Trade Organizations from 70 different countries. WFTO is the first guarantee system of fair trade principles and its members share the goal of fighting poverty through sustainable economic development policies addressing small

producers' groups – mostly farmers and artisans – which are marginalised and crushed by the global market rules. WFTO has its headquarters in the Netherlands and 5 regional headquarters in Africa, Europe, South America, North America and Asia.
